As seniors eagerly prepare for the excitement of commencement ceremonies, they also ready themselves to bid farewell to the Saint Leo campus as they embark on their new adventures.

"We're moving to Washington D.C. for grad school. It's a little nerve wracking, but also really exciting for new experiences," says Alicia Sillen, a senior in marketing.

For many, life after college can be bittersweet, marking both an end to a familiar chapter and the

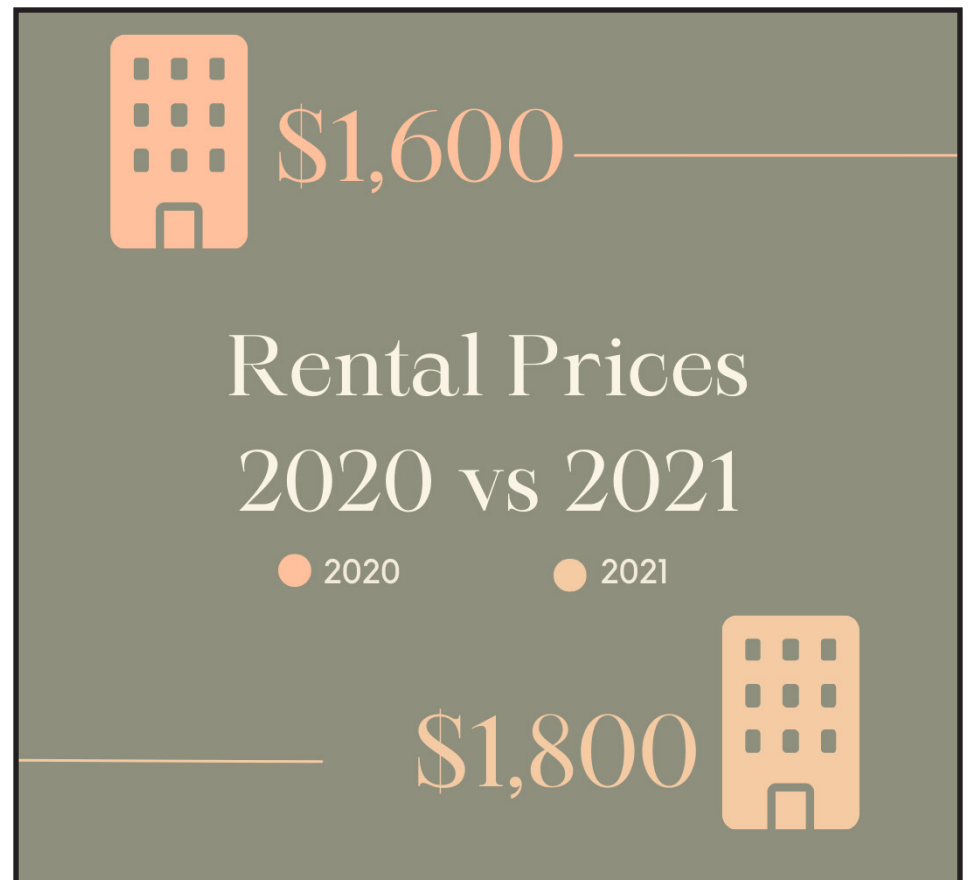
beginning of new adventures as independent adults. While the feeling of moving out isn't entirely unfamiliar to many, it signifies a significant step toward personal growth and self-reliance.

"I'm moving back to Colorado," explains Alejandra Galaviz, a senior in Health humanities with a specialization in pre-med. "The biggest challenge [for me] is leaving me behind the sense of community and my friends because I'll be so far away."

Whether moving off campus entails returning to your childhood home or venturing to a new place, it's normal to experience stress and worry about how to manage the transition.

To help alleviate some stress, Jilian Falvo, a senior majoring in psychology with a general specialization, reflects on how she is preparing to move.

"Try to start slowly packing away some items, like clothes or

anything that you're not going to be using in the next couple of weeks," said Falvo. "Pack those items away so when you do have to move out, you're not stressed, and you have things packed away."

Every student's experience moving post-graduation is unique. While some may return home to their parents, seeking a sense of familiarity, others may opt to live independently or with roommates. Regardless of the chosen path, it's crucial to plan for a smoother transition out of Saint Leo living.

Moving into a new place can feel overwhelming, especially when unsure where to begin. Falvo, who navigated solo living while studying at Saint Leo, offers a piece of advice she wishes she had known beforehand.

"Throw away things that you're not using," Falvo states. "Sometimes it's easy to hold on to things because you think you're going to need them, but the old saying 'less is more' is definitely true in some cases."

Since the pandemic, there has been a trend of more college students living at home due to

the significant rise in rent prices. According to Forbes, there was a notable increase between the fourth quarter of 2020 and 2021, with the median price for an apartment jumping from 1,600 dollars to 1,800 dollars. The cost of living is continuing to rise, so finding ways to save money is imperative.

"We found out that we can load our car on the Amtrak," Sillen said. "I had a family member tell us, so we can fill our cars up with our stuff and take the train instead of paying movers. So much cheaper!"

When moving, students can find different ways to save money such as asking friends to help them move instead of movers, go thrifting or discount stores to purchase necessities once moved in, and take advantage of using student discounts before IDs become invalid.

Moving can be stressful, but it's an experience that fosters growth and marks the beginning of an exciting new chapter for students.

"I have a lot to look forward to," Galaviz says. "Starting dental school and getting more dental experience."

Building a post-grad career? Career Services can help.

It is no secret that most college seniors start getting antsy around graduation, stressing about the next big transition of their life. Whether that is starting a career, moving, or choosing a graduate school, it can all seem overwhelming for a young adult.

Omar Cosme, assistant director of Saint Leo's Career Services department and adjunct communications instructor, spends much of his time working with seniors preparing to make this jump into adulthood. The most common questions he receives revolve around networking and crafting the perfect resume, which are crucial to building a post-grad career.

"Waiting until the last minute to take advantage of networking opportunities can be stressful, but I want students to know Career Services supports alumni as well," Cosme shares. "They have the whole community behind them ... the resources we put out stay activated

and accessible even post-grad."

Career Services offers many services, including resume help, job search tactics, a Career Closet, interview prep, and a newly introduced LeoGreat program, which provides students with an action plan for preparing to jump into a career from any stage in their educational journey.

For busy seniors, who may be juggling hobbies, jobs, classes, and exams, LeoGreat offers a flexible way to participate in career development when their time is more divided than ever. With three modules in the program, and incentives after completing each module, Cosme hopes this will strengthen the relationship between students and Career Services.

These modules include 'Ready to Network,' 'Resume and Interview Prep,' and 'Career Excellence, Ready to be LeoGreat.' For a senior worried about their post-graduation career, this can be a blueprint for success.

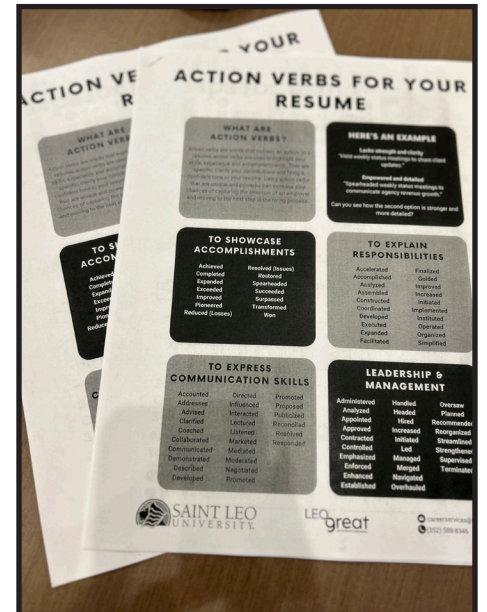
"You'll be able to talk about yourself as a professional, under-

go the process of being hired, and eventually build a fulfilling career," Cosme says. "We often don't talk about these in-between processes ... we're demystifying what happens between graduating and becoming a professional."

After completing the entire program, students will receive a Leo Great pass, which works in a digital and physical space to further career development. It holds a student's resume, LinkedIn, and contact card, which can be digitally transferred just by tapping two phones together. Additionally, it can be used physically as what Cosme calls a "fast pass" for future events with community partners.

"Seniors need to look towards networking as fast as possible ... and the Leo Great pass addresses that issue, so it's a great incentive [for finishing the program]."

Cosme encourages lower-classmen and seniors alike to enjoy the career development process. He points to both professional and on-campus organizations as a great resource for students to get started

on their journey, including the Leo Great program and Career Services.

"Combine your university experience with your networking skills, and now you have something to contribute right away," Cosme says. "You can pick all of this up by being human and making those connections ... this is what I would really recommend for students right now."

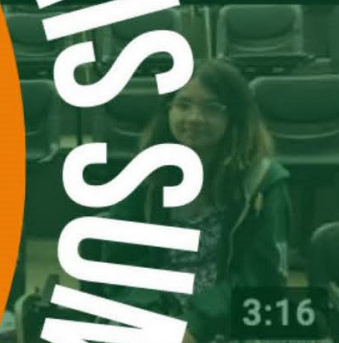

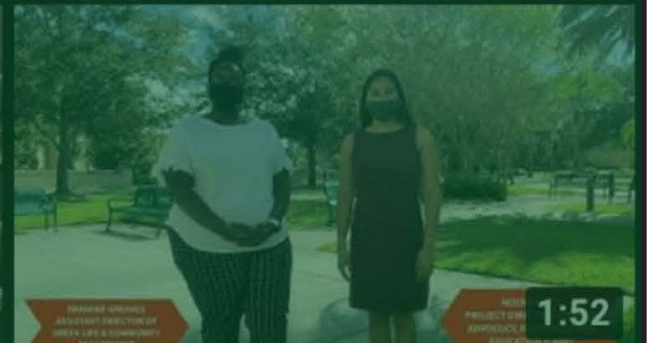
